



He stared right back at me, so i decided he was okay and gave him kisses. Everyone laughed and he chuckled. When I was done He looked up with a big smile and said "I love puppydog kisses". All the people in the room chatted about me and I started looking out the window. When it was time to go, I went back over to him and gave him kisses again, just to make sure he knew I thought he was an okay guy. We left him with my therapy dog card and we were off to visit the next patient. Weeks later I was friended on Facebook by a woman, who then wrote on my wall about how she really appreciated our visit, and how her dad talked all about it, and that he had passed on a week after our visit. I was very touched she reached out to me, since we almost never know anything of the people we visit beyond the hospital. I noticed they scheduled a memorial close to me, and I asked if I

The day of the memorial came and I went with my dad. I was a little nervous because I didn't know what to expect, but everyone was very nice to me. After the service when I told people I was the therapy dog who visited him, they told me he talked about me all the time, and had a big smile on his face, and how he really enjoyed my kisses. They thanked me for the work I did (which really isn't work at all for me) and told me stories about this fellow I visited. I saw a table full of pictures of him (he looked very different than when I saw him at the hospital) and I even saw my therapy dog card on the table!

I got to know a man with many friends and loving family, and I was very touched to be a part of his life in a small way.
